

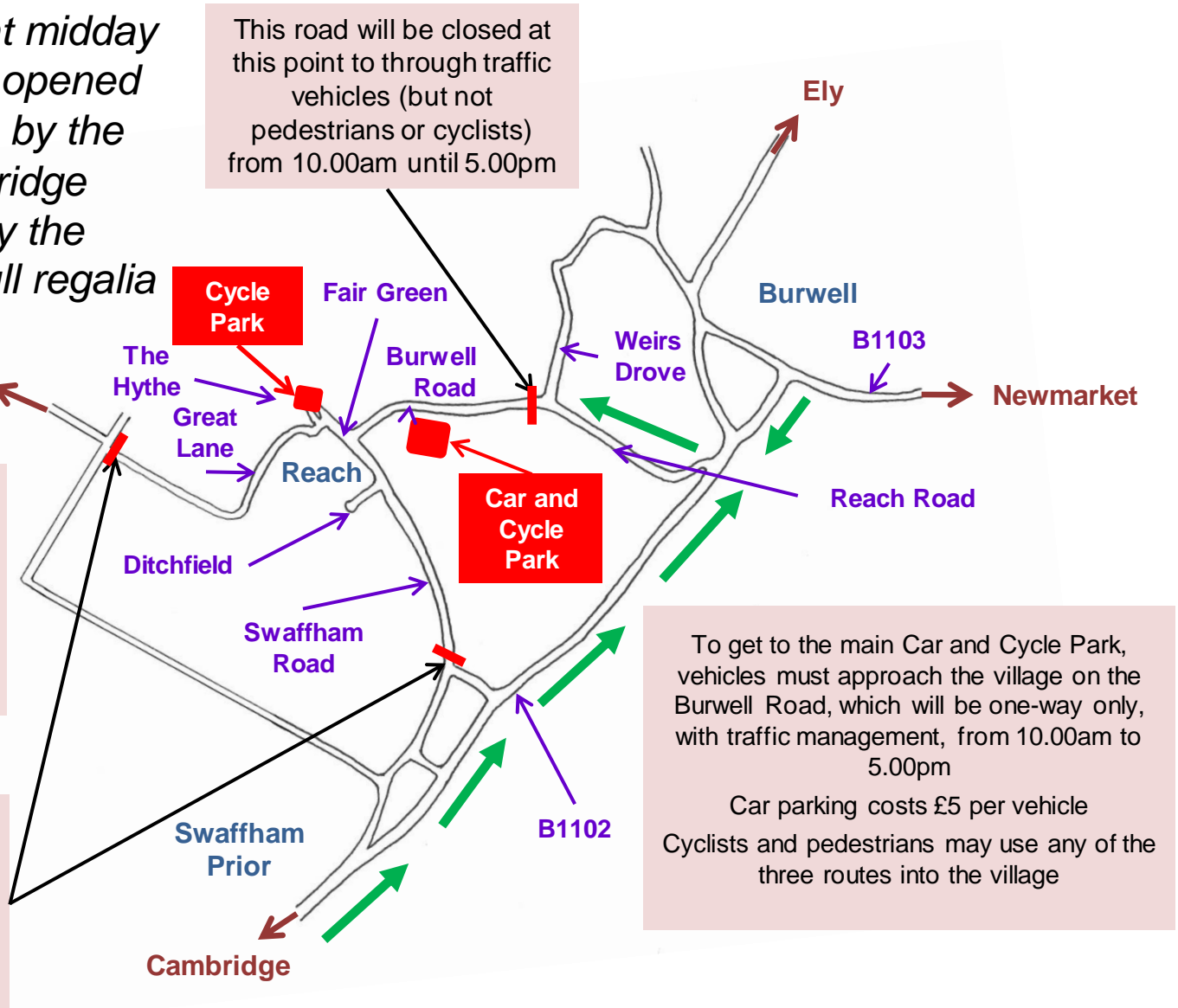
# The ONLY vehicular access to Reach Fair is via the green arrow route

*Reach Fair starts at midday when it is formally opened on the Fair Green by the mayor of Cambridge accompanied by the Aldermen in their full regalia*

This road will be closed at this point to through traffic vehicles (but not pedestrians or cyclists) from 10.00am until 5.00pm

Cycle Parking is **FREE** in the 2 Cycle Parks on the Burwell Road and the Hythe (see map) – please **DO NOT** park in the cemetery or lock your bike to the cemetery railings

These roads will be closed at these points to vehicles (but not pedestrians or cyclists) from 10.00am until 5.00pm



To get to the main Car and Cycle Park, vehicles must approach the village on the Burwell Road, which will be one-way only, with traffic management, from 10.00am to 5.00pm

Car parking costs £5 per vehicle  
Cyclists and pedestrians may use any of the three routes into the village
