By Royal Charter since 1201

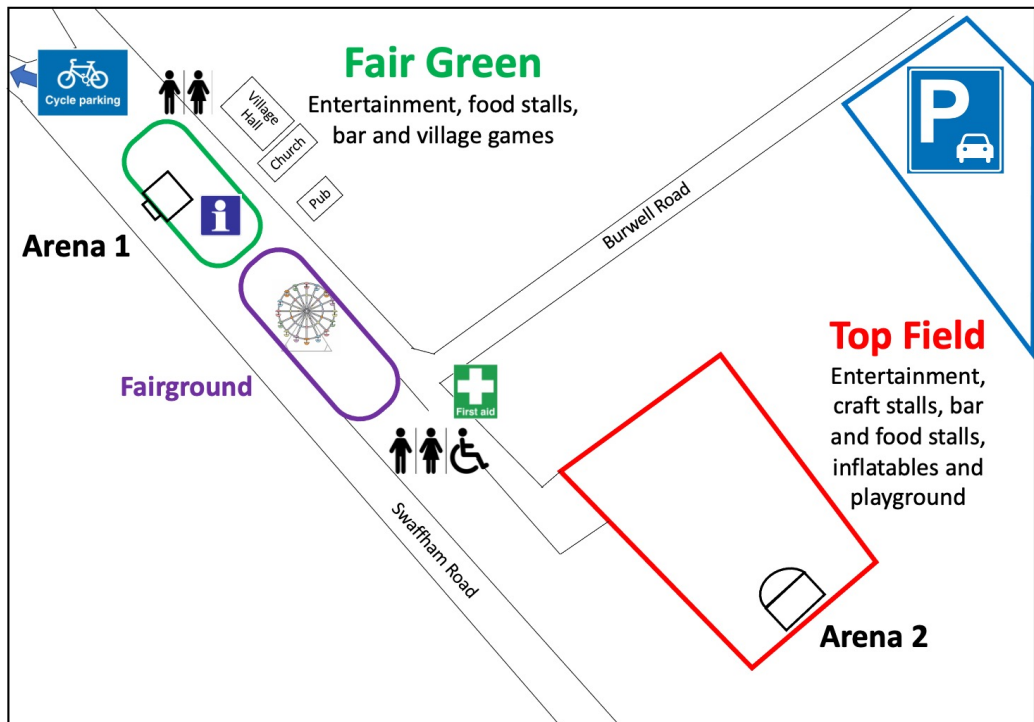
Welcome! We're delighted that you've chosen to visit us today

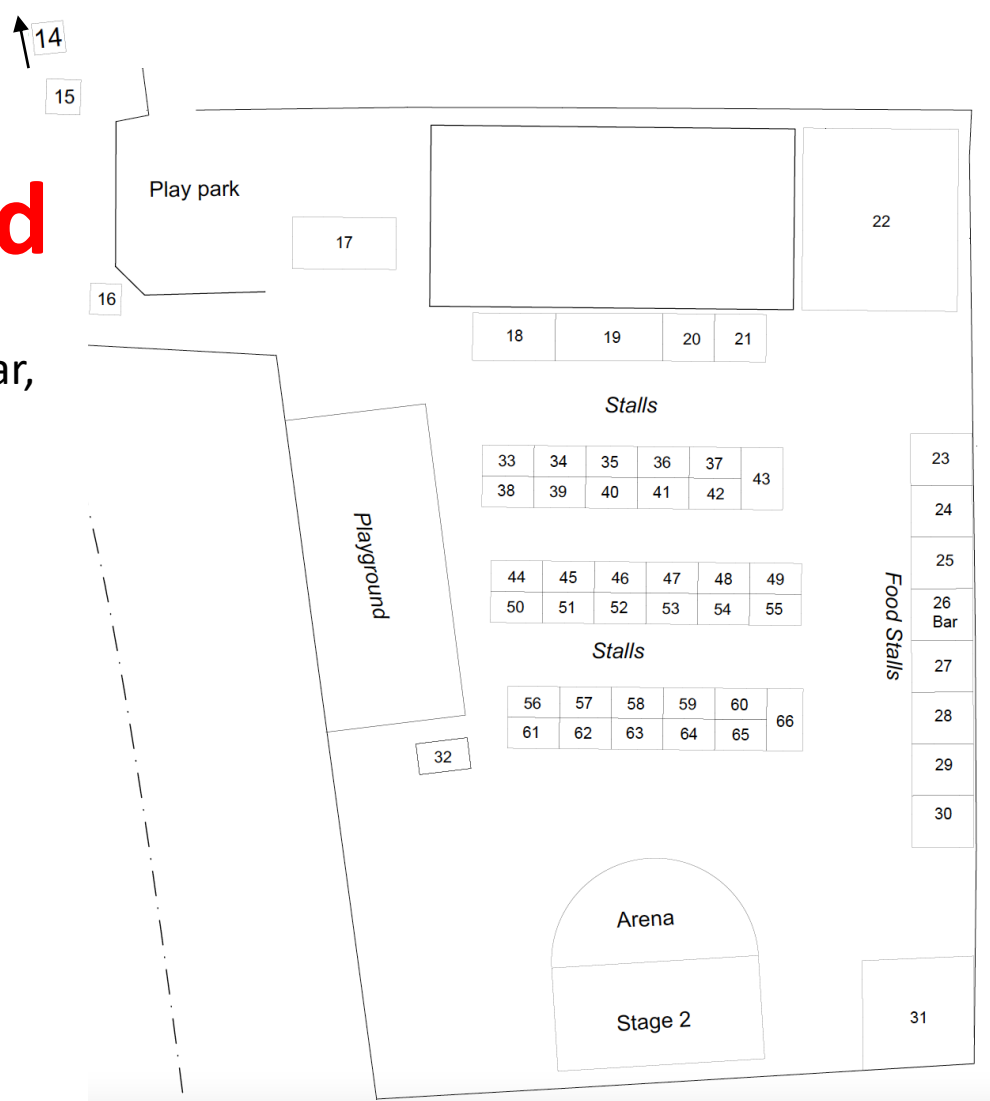

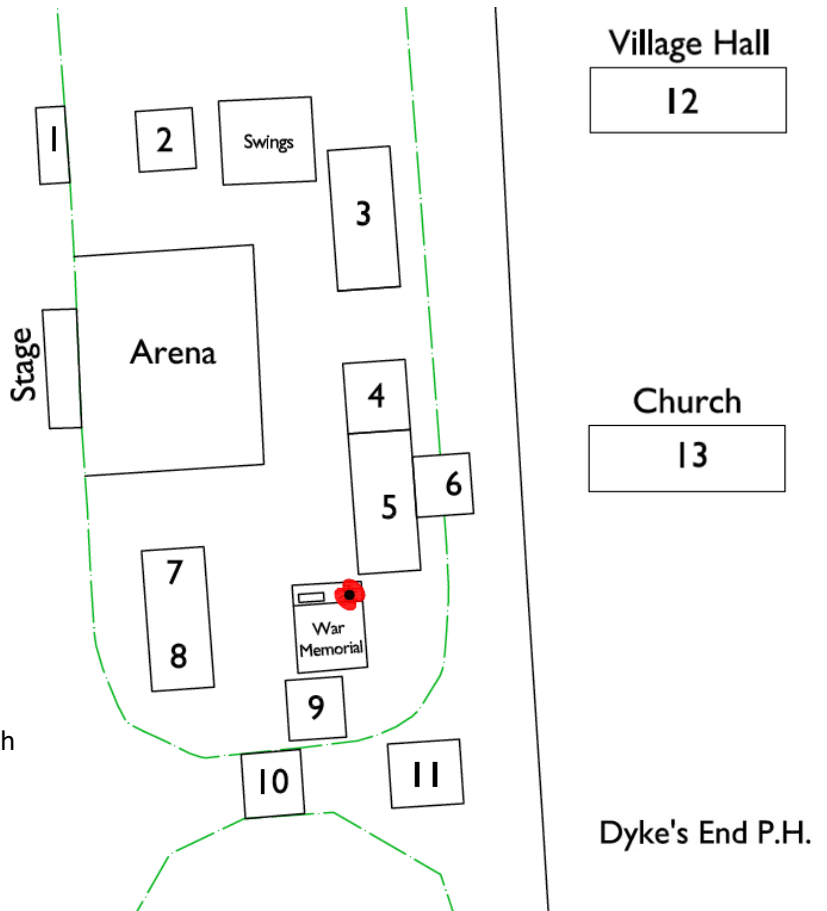
